


ULES Facts...

- 1 VI & 3 Intervention teachers



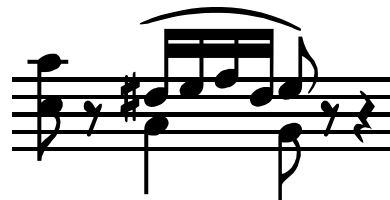
Meetings
