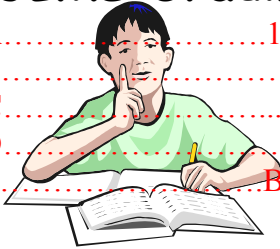


ULMS Facts...

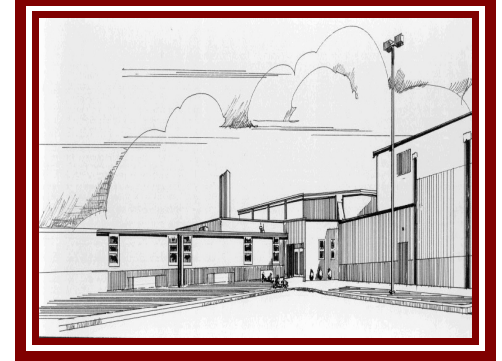
UL's Belief Statements

- Union Local Board of Education meets every 3rd Thursday of the month.

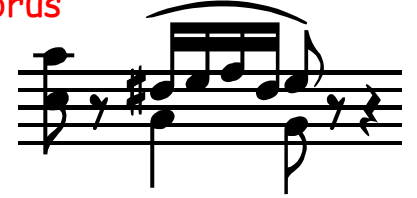
