

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. Please read the criteria for each scholarship. Only apply if you meet the criteria.
2. Please fill out the application in **PEN** and write NEATLY in your handwriting (or type).
3. TRANSCRIPTS--All scholarships require your transcript. There will be a sign-up list in the office. Sign your name and how many transcripts you need. We will get copies for you, but it is YOUR responsibility to attach each transcript. Do not wait until the last day to get transcripts.
4. **You may also attach a list/resume of activities and awards (and write “see attached” instead of writing them out on each application) and make copies for each scholarship (unless it says otherwise).**
5. Please ask teachers/coaches early for letters of recommendation (if needed) so they have enough time to write your letter. (Do not wait until the last minute.)
6. Some scholarships require essays.
7. Almost all the scholarships require your FAFSA EFC. If your parents have not filled out your FAFSA, please do that ASAP. (Colleges need your FAFSA as well to complete your financial aid package. There are also links on the Class of 2023 Google Classroom for help. Go to studentaid.gov)
8. For the Lloyd Ward Memorial Scholarship--Mrs. Eberhart will fill out the form on the application when you turn it in.
9. Copies of scholarships will be in the Guidance Office for those who can't print.
10. Scholarship Banquet is TBA. You will get an invitation the first week of May.
