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Union Local Online/Blended Learning School Contract 2021-2022 School Year

 Except as arranged or exempted by UL administrative and/or guidance staff, Online School students are required to report to the Union Local Learning Center (ULLC) a *minimum* of *two days per week*. Students and parents must meet with ULLC staff, must establish the student's choice of days, and must sign this contract agreeing to adhere to the stated attendance choice.

Student's weekly attendance days:_

- Online/Blended Learning students are required to wear face coverings/masks.
- In order to meet the State's attendance requirements, all students are required to work a minimum of 26 hours per week on their online coursework. These hours will be a combination of in-school and at-home work hours. Failure to meet the required attendance hours/coursework hours may result in the dismissal from ULLC OnLine School.
- In conjunction with the online assignments, students may be required to complete one or more project-based activities which will be averaged with the student's end-of-course grades, as set forth on the student's Individual Learning Path. The student and ULLC teachers/staff will discuss and negotiate end-of- course projects/activities, and those projects/activities will be outlined on the student's Individual Learning Path. As needed and requested, students will receive support and guidance from the ULLC staff with project completion. In addition, students may be required to complete additional writing assignments or activities as determined by individual teachers.
- Students must demonstrate appropriate progress in each course and earn a passing grade of 70% or higher on lessons, quizzes, and tests, and must complete the course in its entirety in order to receive credit for that course.
- Failure to maintain an overall passing grade of 70% may result in dismissal from the program.
