# Online/Blended Learning School for 2021-2022 Fall, 2021

Dear Parents and Students,

We would like to let you know of some important Online School/Blended Learning changes for the 2021-2022 school year. We know that the best way to meet students' needs and support their success is through in-person interaction and instruction. Also, as you know, vaccines are available for students ages 12 and up. Therefore, Union Local will return to the requirement that students who participate in our Online School/Blended Learning program must attend the Union Local Learning Center in person at least two days per week. This modified program will be offered to students in grades 6-12.

If you would like your child to participate in our district's Online School/Blended Learning program next school year, please check the box below indicating your choice, fill in the blanks, and return the form to either the Middle School or High School office by Friday, August 20th. 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# Union Local Online/Blended Learning School Contract 2021-2022 School Year

 Except as arranged or exempted by UL administrative and/or guidance staff, Online School students are required to report to the Union Local Learning Center (ULLC) a minimum of two days per week. Students and parents must meet with ULLC staff, must establish the student's choice of days, and must sign this contract agreeing to adhere to the stated attendance choice.

### Student's weekly attendance days:\_\_\_

- Online/Blended Learning students are required to wear face coverings/masks.
- In order to meet the State's attendance requirements, all students are required to
  work a minimum of 26 hours per week on their online coursework. These hours will
  be a combination of in-school and at-home work hours. Failure to meet the required
  attendance hours/coursework hours may result in the dismissal from ULLC OnLine
  School.
- In conjunction with the online assignments, students may be required to complete one or more project-based activities which will be averaged with the student's end-of-course grades, as set forth on the student's Individual Learning Path. The student and ULLC teachers/staff will discuss and negotiate end-of- course projects/activities, and those projects/activities will be outlined on the student's Individual Learning Path. As needed and requested, students will receive support and guidance from the ULLC staff with project completion. In addition, students may be required to complete additional writing assignments or activities as determined by individual teachers.
- Students must demonstrate appropriate progress in each course and earn a passing grade of 70% or higher on lessons, quizzes, and tests, and must complete the course in its entirety in order to receive credit for that course.
- Failure to maintain an overall passing grade of 70% may result in dismissal from the program.
