Applicant Qualifications

- Must be a student who graduates from high school in 2024 and begins college courses by Fall of 2024.
- Must be a member of Softite Community Federal Credit Union.
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of at least 2.8.
- Must have demonstrated leadership skills and a strong involvement in extracurricular activities, school, or community service organizations.
- Must have demonstrated outstanding citizenship qualities that show a genuine concern for others.

Submission Requirements

- Official Transcript from the high school attended.
- Completed Scholarship application including a **300-500-word essay telling how credit unions such as "Softite" demonstrates the philosophy of the credit union movement.**
- Everything including the official transcript, scholarship application and essay must be received together by 5:00 p.m. EST, Monday April 1, 2024 at the address below. No fax or e-mail submission will be accepted or considered.
