General Information

- Up to three (3) \$500 scholarships may be awarded annually to selected candidates who best meet or exceed the minimum requirements. These scholarships will be available to be awarded annually if suitable applications are received.
- Applicant must have completed three years of Ag-Ed.
- Following completion of a minimum of one semester and a maximum of two semesters, the recipient will be required to submit a copy of their transcript to the Union Local FFA Alumni.
- The Alumni Treasurer will write a check for scholarship amount on presentation of the transcript.
- This application in entirety is due to Mrs. Baker by email no later than April 15 of the calendar year.
- Nothing on this application should be changed other than filling in the required information. Doing so could make you ineligible.
